It is with immense joy and pride that I, the Principal of TRIS present the annual report of The Rajas International School for the academic year 2023-24. This year has been a journey filled with achievements, growth, and the celebration of our school's rich academic and cultural tapestry as usual.

- ➤ I'm happy to share that in CBSE board exam 2022-23, Shaaru Shivani.N.J of Grade 12 secured 486/500, Athithi Devi secured 482/500, Mohammed Farhan secured 469/500 with a overall average of 73% and our school tops in the district.
- ➤ In grade 10, Master Dharun karthi secured 475/500, Tharun Nallasivam secured 468/500, Udhith kanithan secured 466/500 with an overall average of 79%
- ➤ I feel excited to inform that 23% of our students successfully cleared the NEET exam and secured admissions in various medical colleges and 27% is waiting to clear NEET exam and the remaining of our students joined in professional and various courses in reputed universities.
- ➤ In the quality standards checking by CBSE boards, we have secured a score of 83.01% and we are in the initial stage towards Accreditation.
- ➤ 30% of our teachers have completed school Innovation training program of 72 hours duration of Ministry of Education's innovation cell, AICTE and CBSE and Ministry of Education have certified our school for establishing school innovation council.

- ➤ We set standards and goals for ourselves and strive to achieve them in the area of academics, sports, discipline, leadership and more. To ensure that we offer AI, Robotics, Design thinking in addition to the regular curriculum.
- ➤ To showcase the passion for discovery and problem solving we are conducting Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) exams in all subjects, NASO National Astronomy and Science Olympiad, International Spell Bee, KAMP, Assessment of Scholastic Skills through Educational Test (ASSET) and National level French Olympiad.

We also provide a vast range of additional programmes to support the students in their academic social, cultural and physical development.
